# Day 2 - Turrialba

## Saturday, February 18

Today we will continue our exploration of the Turrialba District and discover CATIE. CATIE, translated The Tropical Agricultural Research and Higher Education Center, is an international institute for agricultural development and biological conservation in Central America and the Caribbean, combining science, education, and innovation. From there we will move on to visit Hacienda Tayutic, a working farm where macadamia nuts, coffee, bananas, and sugar cane are grown. The old way of processing sugar cane, using oxen to squeeze the juice will be demonstrated.

## Day 5 – Central Pacific

## Tuesday, February 21

After breakfast, we will attend the Villa Vanilla Spice Farm, located in the Central Pacific rainforest. In addition to vanilla, the expansive farm harvests true Ceylon cinnamon, cocoa, black pepper, turmeric, and exotic fruits, as well as essential oil and medicinal plants. You will receive a hands-on tour, meander along the winding plantation trail and shop for souvenirs. After lunch, we will be off to Manuel Antonio National Park, one of the most bio-diverse areas in the world. Boasting enthralling rain forests, pristine beaches, and gorgeous coral reefs, this is an ultimate destination for outdoor explorers. The forest is mecca for birdwatchers, housing more than 350 spectacular species, including toucans and emerald Amazon kingfishers.

**PLEASE NOTE** — This trip is suitable for all ages if you are in good health, get regular exercise, enjoy the wilderness, and have a good-humored approach to traveling in Latin America — where things might not go as predictably as they do at home. Our trip is not strenuous and can be considered predominantly leisurely-to-moderate. Elevation gains and losses on most walks will be minimal, but there are some steep walkways at some resorts in the mountains. In order to fully enjoy this trip, you'll need to be willing to accept the many surprises this marvelous environment has in store for us!

Although this trip is focused on botanical aspects, **no prior knowledge about plants is necessary to enjoy this tour.** And all aspects of the natural world and culture are included where appropriate. Our Costa Rican guide and driver have extensive knowledge of the plants, ecology, culture, and history of Costa Rica — they are also expert birders and speak excellent English.

Please note that changes to the itinerary may be necessary due to weather, or other factors beyond our control. Participants must be able to endure moderate physical activity (daily activities include 2-4 hours of walking and 3-4 hours of bus rides) and should be in good overall health!
